



From the DESK of... Fr. Peter

WHATEVER HAPPENS...

We have been trained to look for someone whom we can blame - except our own selves, of course! In this "blame-game" we also start to blame GOD for many things. Just think: GOD gave us free will to chose the good and love and freedom,... but instead we chose self over others and that is when it gets ugly. Because of people's greed - many people suffer. Because of people's desire for power - the weaker are exploited. Because of people's uncontrolled lust - many, many people suffer and are victims. And we blame GOD for all this?

It just does not seem fair, does it? GOD who is all good, wants us to BE good too. And He gives us the power through Baptism and the Sacraments. This supernatural power in us allows us to choose truth, the good, the beautiful,... But how many live like this? Maybe a handful, at the most.

Our good heavenly Father allows evil (an absence of good) to be present on earth - so that we might learn to find our way back to Him. GOD speaks to each soul individually. A few listen, but most drown out the voice of GOD through noise (TV, radio, electronic gadgets,...) or stimulants like alcohol or drugs, or pleasure (immoral acts),... In other words, GOD has a hard time to get through to us - and yet, we blame our good LORD for all the turmoil in this world?

THE BOOK OF PROVERBS (3:24-35)

When you lie down, you will not be afraid,
when you rest, your sleep will be sweet.
Do not be afraid of sudden terror,
of the ruin of the wicked when it comes;
For the LORD will be your confidence,
and will keep your foot from the snare.
Do not withhold any goods from the owner
when it is in your power to act.
Say not to your neighbor, "Go, come back tomorrow,
and I will give it to you," when all the while you have it.
Do not plot evil against your neighbors,
when they live at peace with you.
Do not contend with someone without cause,
with one who has done you no harm.
Do not envy the violent
and choose none of their ways:
To the LORD the devious are an abomination,
but the upright are close to him.
The curse of the LORD is on the house of the wicked,
but the dwelling of the just he blesses;
Those who scoff, he scoffs at,
but the lowly he favors.
The wise will possess glory,
but fools will bear shame.



SOCIALISM - PART 2

...continued from last week...

This quote is from paragraph 17 and shows how Socialists "strive against nature":

It must be first of all recognized that the condition of things inherent in human affairs must be borne with, for it is impossible to reduce civil society to one dead level. Socialists may in that intent do their utmost, but all striving against nature is in vain. There naturally exist among mankind manifold differences of the most important kind; people differ in capacity, skill, health, strength; and unequal fortune is a necessary result of unequal condition. Such un-equality is far from being disadvantageous either to individuals or to the community. Social and public life can only be maintained by means of various kinds of capacity for business and the playing of many parts; and each man, as a rule, chooses the part which suits his own peculiar domestic condition. As regards bodily labor, even had man never fallen from the state of innocence, he would not have remained wholly idle; but that which would then have been his free choice and his delight became afterwards compulsory, and the painful expiation for his disobedience. "Cursed be the earth in thy work; in thy labor thou shalt eat of it all the days of thy life." (RN #17)



So what can we summarize about the condemnation of Socialism from Pope Leo XIII's Rerum Novarum:

Socialism promotes envy between classes. But GOD says: "Thou shalt not covet thy neighbors goods." Socialism says: The transfer of private property to community property is against nature and justice. Socialism hurts the working man first and foremost. A person has the right to improve his social condition through labor. His social condition should not be taken away from him. Socialism perceives children as belonging to the State chiefly, and thus the State has a prior right over the father of the child with regard to guardianship, education, and labor. This the Pope condemns. But GOD says: "Honor your father and mother." Socialism must be "utterly rejected." Socialism leads to "condition of misery and degradation." The Pope recognizes that not every human has equal aptitude in this life for wage-earning. Labor is good and not evil. Socialism wrongly presumes that work is always an exploitation of one class serving another class. It is evident in these quotes, but especially elsewhere, that those who have acquired private property should share their goods with those who are in need. This is the call to almsgiving that Proverbs and Christ repeatedly ex-

hort us to practice.



Pope LEO XIII (1878-1903):

Overthrow is Deliberately Planned

For, the fear of God and reverence for divine laws being taken away, the authority of rulers despised, sedition permitted and approved, and the popular passions urged on to lawlessness, with no restraint save that of punishment, a change and overthrow of all things will necessarily follow. Yea, this change and overthrow is deliberately planned and put forward by many associations of communists and socialists."

(Encyclical Humanum Genus, April 20, 1884, n. 27)

Debasing the Natural Union of Man and Woman

"They [socialists, communists, or nihilists] debase the natural union of man and woman, which is held sacred even among barbarous peoples; and its bond, by which the family is chiefly held together, they weaken, or even deliver up to lust. (Encyclical Quod Apostolici Muneris, December 28, 1878, n. 1)

The Harvest of Misery

...there is need for a union of brave minds with all the resources they can command. The harvest of misery is before our eyes, and the dreadful projects of the most disastrous national upheavals are threatening us from the growing power of the socialistic movement." (Encyclical Graves de Communi Re, January 18, 1901, n. 21)

Pope SAINT PIUS X (1903-1914)

The Dream of Re-Shaping Society will Bring Socialism "But stranger still, alarming and saddening at the same time, are the audacity and frivolity of men who call themselves Catholics and dream of re-shaping society under such conditions, and of establishing on earth, over and beyond the pale of the Catholic Church, 'the reign of love and justice' ... What are they going to produce? ... A mere verbal and chimerical construction in which we shall see, glowing in a jumble, and in seductive confusion, the words Liberty, Justice, Fraternity, Love, Equality, and human exultation, all resting upon an ill-understood human dignity. It will be a tumultuous agitation, sterile for the end proposed, but which will benefit the less Utopian exploiters of the people. Yes, we can truly say that the Sillon, its eyes fixed on a chimera, brings Socialism in its train." (Apostolic Letter Notre Charge Apostolique [Our Apostolic Mandate] to the French Bishops, August 15, 1910, condemning the movement Le Sillon)
