From the DESK of... Fr. Peter

The Month of May (it's about loving!)

We all love something, somewhere, somehow, sometime. But there are things we love more than others. People, for example. And among people there are those whom we are drawn closer to, than others. The proper term for this is: "LOVE," especially, when we speak about relationships. One person to another person. And among the ones we love most, ought to be our parents, siblings, spouse and children. And out of all these "close relationships" we find that the love for MOTHER sticks out by far.

When you see a videos where kids are at camp and they are being videotaped and asked to say something to their parents: 9 out of 10 kids say "Hi, Mom!" That alone says it all. Mother is "love in-personated."

Now this is all on the natural level - now let us kick it up a notch! Supernaturally - we also have a mother: The Church. We became a child of GOD at the Baptismal Font and can now call GOD our Father. But until we are old enough to see Him (face to face, when we leave this world for good), it is mother Church who takes care of us. And this is what she does best. Loving us endlessly and always encouraging us to look towards and to live in the supernatural reality that is more real then anything we can experience in this material world.

Jesus had a mother, the Blessed Virgin. He was not selfish, and when He was on the cross, He gave us all that He had left - His Mother. We ought to take her into our hearts and minds and listen to her, as she tries to make us into "other" Jesus.' She was given the title: Mother of Grace - for she distributes the wealth of heaven. Spoon feeding us, so to speak, to take in the supernatural life, which makes us holy and GOD pleasing. For this reason we consecrated us to her through a "Marian Consecration."

May is the month of Mary. On a May 13, the Fatima apparitions began - some 100 years ago. Through the Church, Mary calls us to return to her Divine Son, to let go of sin and make sacrifices. Mary said to the children: "Pray, pray a great deal, and make sacrifices for sinners, for many souls go to hell because they have no one to sacrifice and pray for them."



Love, let's not stay on the natural level, but move into the reality of GRACE. Let's learn to love Mary and the Church as are proper to them. Wear the Brown Scapular, recite the Rosary daily, go to Holy Mass whenever you are able and stop by the Church on the way home from work.



MAY - ABOUT OUR HEAVENLY MOTHER


The world being unworthy to receive the Son of God directly from the hands of the Father, he gave his Son to Mary for the world to receive him from her. The Son of God became man for our salvation but only in Mary and

through Mary. God the Holy Spirit formed Jesus Christ in Mary but only after having asked her consent through one of the chief ministers of his court. God the Father imparted to Mary his fruitfulness as far as a mere creature was capable of receiving it, to enable her to bring forth his Son and all the members of his mystical body. God the Son came into her virginal womb as a new Adam into his earthly paradise, to take his delight there and produce hidden wonders of grace. God-made-man

found freedom in imprisoning himself in her womb. He displayed power in allowing himself to be borne by this young maiden. He found his glory and that of his Father in hiding his splendor from all creatures here below and revealing them only to Mary. He glorified his independence and his majesty in depending upon this loveable virgin in his conception, his birth, his presentation in the temple, and in the thirty years of his hidden life. Even at his death she had to be present so that he might be united with her in one sacrifice and be immolated with her consent to the eternal Father, just as formerly Isaac was offered in sacrifice by Abraham when he accepted the will of God. It was Mary who nursed him, fed him, cared for him, reared him, and sacrificed him for us. The Holy Spirit could not leave such wonderful and inconceivable dependence of God unmentioned in the Gospel, though he concealed almost all the wonderful things that Wisdom Incarnate did during his hidden life in order to bring home to us its infinite value and glory. Jesus gave more glory to God his Father by submitting to his Mother for thirty years than he would have given him had he converted the whole world by working the greatest miracles. How highly then do we glorify God when to please him we submit ourselves to Mary, taking Jesus as our sole model. If we examine



closely the remainder of the life of Jesus Christ, we see that he chose to begin his miracles through Mary. It was by her word that he sanctified Saint John the Baptist in the womb of his mother, Saint Elizabeth; no sooner had Mary spoken than John was sanctified. This was his first and greatest miracle of grace. At the wedding in Cana he

changed water into wine at her humble prayer, and this was his first miracle in the order of nature. He began and continued his miracles through Mary and he will continue them through her until the end of time.

Thou shalt be the Friend, the Defender and the Chieftainess of all the just and of our friends; all of them Thou shalt comfort, console and fill with blessings according to their devotion to Thee. In view of all this we make Thee the Depository of our riches, the Treasurer of our goods; we place into thy hands the helps and blessings of our grace for distribution; nothing do We wish to be given to the world, which does not pass through thy hands; and nothing do We deny, which Thou wishest to concede to men. Grace shall be diffused in thy lips for obtaining all that Thou wishest and ordainest in heaven and on earth, and everywhere shall angels and men obey Thee; because whatever is ours shall be thine, just as Thou hast always been ours; and Thou shalt reign with Us forever.
